# 12. PARKING ARRANGEMENTS AT THE WAR MEMORIAL HALL PERMISSIVE PARKING AREA

Following a meeting with Golf Club committee members, Councillor Mrs Worrall and Cllr Watkins would like to propose to Full Council the implementation of parking restrictions at the WMH permitted parking area between the hours of 12 noon and 2 pm. There has been concern at the Golf Club for some time regarding the number of commuter's cars parked there all day( up to 20 have been counted ). This obviously restricts golfers and Hall users alike, to the extent that both parties are losing business because of this. The Golf Club have implied that they are willing to help fund the cost of solar parking meters to the sum of £1,000.
