10/14 REPRESENTATIONS FROM THE DISTRICT AND COUNTY COUNCILLORS

Written representation was received from County Councillor Hayward and District Councillor Trevett. at the meeting The meeting was suspended at 8.03pm in order that Members could read the reports. The meeting re-convened at 8.06pm

Members were concerned about the proposal to extend the parking scheme to Capel Road and were interested in the consultation with affected residents. There was a general view that parking restricts should be resisted until proven necessary.
