1. A letter has been received from Three Rivers District Council advising that — an appeal has been made to the Secretary of State against the Council's decision. The appeal follows the refusal of planning permission by the Council for the following reasons:-

- 2. The development fails to provide adequate provision for the access, turning and manoeuvring of waste recovery and recycling vehicles as well as emergency vehicles within the site. This would result in inadequate arrangements for the storage and collection of waste and a substandard development contrary to Policies H14, N10, GEN1 and Appendix 1 of the Three Rivers Local Plan 1996-2011.
- 2 The development fails to comprehensively address the characteristics, opportunities and constraints of the wider site as a whole which would result in piecemeal development of the site. Such piecemeal development would fail to protect the existing character of the area and be detrimental to the street scene and appearance of the area contrary to Policies H14 and GEN1 and Appendix 1 of the Three Rivers Local Plan 1996-2011.
