### **THE HERTFORDSHIRE (TEMPORARY CLOSING OF NEW PARADE AND MAIN PARADE, CHORLEYWOOD DURING THE 'CHORLEYWOOD COMMUNITY FRENCH MARKET') ORDER 2017**

NOTICE is given that the Hertfordshire County Council intend to make an Order under Section 16(A) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, to prohibit all traffic from using the following lengths of roads:-

1. that length of New Parade, Chorleywood from its southernmost junction with Whitelands Avenue south westwards, north westwards and north eastwards to its northernmost junction with Whitelands Avenue, a distance of approximately 80 metres.
2. that length of Main Parade, Chorleywood from its northernmost junction with Whitelands Avenue north eastwards, south eastwards and north eastwards for its entire length.

There are no alternative routes available for vehicles whilst the event takes place. However vehicular access to properties in these roads will be maintained whenever possible throughout the duration of the event.

The sections of roads will each be closed between the hours of 6.00am and 6.00pm on Sunday 7 May 2017, when signs are in place.

The purpose of the Order is to ensure public safety and prevent accidents for the duration of the 'Chorleywood Community French Market'.
