THE HERTFORDSHIRE (TEMPORARY CLOSING OF MAIN PARADE, CHORLEYWOOD DURING THE 'CHORLEYWOOD COMMUNITY ITALIAN MARKET') ORDER 2017

NOTICE is given that the Hertfordshire County Council intends to make an Order under Section 16(A) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, to prohibit all traffic from using that length of Main Parade, Chorleywood from its northernmost junction with Whitelands Avenue north eastwards, south eastwards and north eastwards for a distance of approximately 98 metres.

There is no alternative route available for vehicles whilst the event takes place. However vehicular access to properties in this road will be maintained whenever possible throughout the duration of the event.

The section of road will be closed between the hours of 6.00am and 6.00pm on Sunday 20 August 2017, when signs are in place.

The purpose of the Order is to ensure public safety and prevent accidents for the duration of the 'Chorleywood Community Italian Market'.

A copy of the proposed Order may be inspected free of charge at County Hall, Hertford between the hours of 9.00am and 5.00pm (excluding weekends, bank and public holidays).
