

## HERTFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

### THE HERTFORDSHIRE (TEMPORARY CLOSING OF DIMMOCKS LANE, SARRATT AND NEW ROAD, SARRATT/NORTH HILL, CHORLEYWOOD) ORDER 2017

NOTICE is given that the Hertfordshire County Council intend to make an Order under Section 16(A) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose of facilitating the making of a film (which is a 'relevant event' under the Act of 1984), the effect of which will be:-

1. To prohibit all traffic between the hours of 6.00am and 2.00pm from using that length of Dimmocks Lane, Sarratt from its junction with Deadmans Ash Lane north westwards to its junction with Church Lane, a distance of approximately 327 metres, except for access.

An alternative route will be via Sarratt Road, Redhall Lane, Chandlers Lane, Toms Hill, Bucks Hill, The Common, The Street, Dunny Lane, Poles Hill & The Green.

2. To prohibit all traffic between the hours of 2.00pm and 6.30pm from using that length of New Road, Sarratt/North Hill, Chorleywood from its junction with Church Lane south eastwards and south westwards for a distance of approximately 1655 metres, except for access.

An alternative route will be via Church Lane, Dimmocks Lane, Sarratt Road, Solesbridge Lane, A404 (Rickmansworth Road/Chenies Road) & North Hill.

The lengths of roads will each be closed on Sunday 30 July 2017, when signs are in place. Alternative signed routes will be provided for traffic whilst the road closures are in place.
