THE HERTFORDSHIRE (TEMPORARY CLOSING OF QUICKLEY LANE, CHORLEYWOOD) ORDER 2016

NOTICE is given that the Hertfordshire County Council intends to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, to prohibit all traffic from using that length of Quickley Lane, Chorleywood from its junction with Rendlesham Way south westwards for a distance of approximately 40 metres ("the Road").

An alternative route will be via Quickley Lane, Hillside Road, Shire Lane, Heronsgate Road and Quickley Lane.

The Order is needed because gas connection works are proposed to be executed on or near the Road.

If the Order is made, it shall come into force on 28 November 2016 for a period of up to 18 months. However, the restrictions specified shall only take effect at the times indicated by signs on or near the Road.

A copy of the proposed Order may be inspected free of charge at County Hall, Hertford between the hours of 9.00am and 5.00pm (excluding weekends, bank and public holidays).
