I understand a statutory agreement was recently signed between Herts County Council and the Boundaries Commission confirming a change in the boundaries between two wards in Three Rivers District. There appears to be no right of appeal to this agreement The Parish Council were not included in any discussion on this matter

I further understand that part of this agreement requires the Parish to hold an election in May 2018; This will be for a period of one year. A further election will then go back into the normal four cycles will take place in May 2019

As far as can be gathered there will not be any changes in the Parish Boundaries but we will still have to hold the two elections at a cost to the Parish of around £40,000.00

Such a cost will have an effect on the precept and cause a great deal of concern within the electorate

I believe we should raise our objections at the highest level after all our Member of Parliament is now the Justice Secretary
