Further details/Other crime/Outcomes

- This month we have seen a few burglaries/ attempted burglaries.
- On June 6 there was an attempted burglary in Loudwater. The offender was disturbed by neighbours and a man has since been charged in connection with the incident.
- There was another attempted burglary on June 10, in Overchess Ridge. Offenders failed to gain entry.
- On the June 30 there were three burglaries. Two in Whitelands Avenue and the other in Greenbury Close.
- There have been a few thefts from motor vehicles – in South Road on June 16 and in The Clump on June 22. Both saw tools stolen from vans.
- All these incidents have or are being investigated and where appropriate house to house enquiries conducted and crime prevention advice given to residents in the area of the incidents.

*ASB is not defined as ‘crime’ however it has been included in this table for your information as it can affect the wider community and we (police) are jointly responsible with local councils for dealing with it. Recordable ASB includes neighbour disputes and noise nuisance, as well as issues such as regular rowdy behaviour in public places.

Distraction burglaries are on the rise across Hertfordshire so please be aware of who you are opening the door to; if they have no ID don’t entertain them. Shut the door and call 101, if you feel threatened call 999.

Please keep in mind that vehicles need to be protected just as much as your house. Don’t leave anything valuable in your car and always make sure it is locked. If you are unsure as to whether it is or not please double check, there is nothing wrong with checking a second time round.
